Examples of Ideas Not Moving Forward

Parks and Open Spaces

- Surcharges on event tickets
- Increase dog license fees
- Create a Parks Board for fundraising

Recreation and Sport Facility Access; Recreation and Culture Programming

- Reduce subsidies in the Leisure Access Program
- Close aging/underutilized facilities or reduce inventory

Fire Rescue Services

- Reduce staff overnight at specific stations where calls reliably decrease between the hours of 1am and 8am
- Longer response times for outlying areas and/or new developments
- Reduce crew size on ladder units
