


Context For A Possible Amendment - Legal Status

- Bylaw 19408 (August 1, 2020) requires face coverings to be worn in indoor public spaces and on public vehicles
- Provincial order (December 8, 2020) duplicated the City's indoor masking requirements
- Province's Stage 3 Open For Summer Plan (July 1, 2021) ends the masking requirement with possible unspecified exceptions
- Unless amended by Council, Bylaw 19408 remains in effect until December 31, 2021

Edmonton Zone New Cases by Month






COVID-19 Update - Edmonton Zone Vaccination Rates

Considerations For the Amendment Options

Guiding Principles:

- Follow CMOH advice and guidance for reopening safety :
 - Reasonable to remove masking requirement with 70% first dose immunization
 - Masking is only one tool in the toolbox
- Decision will:
 - Consider resource impacts
 - Be inclusive and fair
 - Support our economy
 - Be consistent with City Plan

Other Considerations:

- Community responses to Stage 3 are mixed and variable
- Consideration for continuation of masks on transit and public vehicles



4 Bylaw Amendment Options

- **1. Deactivate mandatory requirement** for masks consistent with Stage 3 (July 1). *Bylaw remains in place, but not effective*.
- **2. Deactivate mandatory requirement** for masks after 50% fully immunized in Edmonton Health Zone. *Bylaw remains in place, but not effective*.
- **3. Repeal** the Bylaw at start of Stage 3.
- **4. Continue** with existing requirements until December 31, 2021
