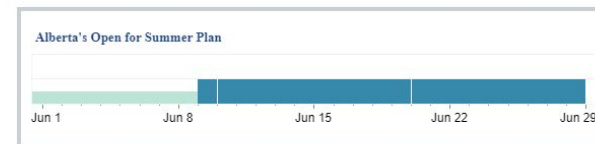

Open for Summer - Stage 3

- Most public health restrictions ended
- COVID-19 testing and contact tracing will continue
- Symptomatic individuals, close contacts, and confirmed cases must isolate
- Masks required in health care facilities and public transportation

Mask Requirements

- City of Edmonton Bylaw deactivated as of July 1
- Provincial Order mandates masks on public transportation
- Peace officer authority to enforce provincial orders ended July 1
- Albertans encouraged to assess their personal level of risk
- Private businesses may continue to require masks

Mask Requirements - Jurisdictional scan

- **Edmonton area municipalities ended mask requirements by July 1**
 - Requirements for municipal employees and facilities vary
- **National context**
 - City of Calgary bylaw repealed July 5
 - BC ended mask requirements July 1
 - Saskatchewan masking requirements will end July 11
 - Ontario remains in its Stage 2

Recreation update - summer programs

- City Arts Centre
 - Day camps and adult programs (July 5)
- John Walter Museum
 - Day camps and drop-in access (July 5)
- Children's Programs
 - Playgrounds and outdoor camps (July 12)

Staffing Update

- 1,300 staff originally on temporary layoff
- 994 staff have received their return to work notice
- 133 staff resigned upon receiving their recall notice
- Recruitment ongoing to fill vacant positions due to resignations
- Remaining staff will be recalled over the coming months

Edmonton Public Library

- Most public services are now available or restarting
- Will begin operating at 100% capacity on July 12 and full hours of operation by August 15
- Hiring blitz to fill current staff vacancies

Vulnerable Population

- Extreme Weather Response in place
- Low case counts and close contacts
- Vaccination continues with the majority of shots being second dose
- Day drop-in locations no longer have COVID-19 space restrictions
- AHS Shelter Guidelines for COVID-19 remain in place for 24/7 and overnight shelters

City Hall Reopening

Current

- Council Chambers open to up to 15 Elected Officials/Admin
- River Valley Room access for candidates by appointment only
- The Hallway Cafe is open with safety protocols in place
- Fountain and change rooms are open with frequent cleaning

August 9

- City Room to be publicly accessible (no public event bookings)
- 311 information counter opens
- Council Chambers open to Councillors, media, and public (33% capacity)

September 20

- Council Chambers available at full capacity
- Last day for nominations appointments in River Valley Room

Post Election

- Public bookings in City Room resume
- River Valley Room serves as Committee space
