RESERVE DESIGNATION BYLAW  
(Skyrattler)

Whereas, pursuant to section 665 (1) of the Municipal Government Act, a Council may pass bylaws designating parcels of land it owns as Municipal Reserve, School Reserve or Municipal and School reserve:

**PART 1 - PURPOSE, DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION**

**PURPOSE**

1. This bylaw designates certain lands owned by the City of Edmonton as Municipal Reserve.

Council hereby requires that the following parcel generally shown on Schedule A be designated as Municipal Reserve by the Registrar of Alberta Land Titles:

EXCEPTING THEREOUT ALL MINES AND MINERALS

PLAN 7821443  
BLOCK 30  
LOT 7  
EXCEPTING THEREOUT ALL MINES AND MINERALS

PLAN 7822821  
BLOCK 30  
LOT 16  
EXCEPTING THEREOUT ALL MINES AND MINERALS

The Registrar shall do all things necessary to give effect to this bylaw, including cancelling the existing Certificate of Title and issuing a new Certificate of Title with the designation of Municipal Reserve, which shall be identified by a number suffixed by the letters "MR".

### PART 3 - GENERAL
