
Statutory Plan / Bylaw Status



 - 50% of trips are made by transit and active transportation; 15-minute districts that allow people to easily complete their daily needs






Equity & Inclusion

Free monthly passess for individuals experiencing houselessness or at-risk. 2,000+ passes / month






