


Foundational Documents

- Municipal Emergency Plan

Office Emergency Management (OEM)



- Provides information to Emergency AdvisoryCommittee
 - Includes Mayor and Council
- Emergency Operations Centre
- Emergency Management Agency
- Emergency Support Response Team
- Business Continuity Management

First responders, Frontline workers & Supporting Agencies	Implement


EAC Roles/Responsibilities

In a regular meeting:

- Receive program updates
- Provide guidance and direction
- Approve emergency plans and programs
- Participate in prescribed training and exercises
- Awareness of need for a special meeting of the Advisory Committee

In a special meeting:

- Declare, renew, or terminate a State of Local Emergency
- Receive updates from Emergency Management Agency
- External communications aligned with official messaging
