Options for a mask bylaw

- Triggered by case rates
 - 10 days at rates below 100/100,000 (current)
 - 28 days at rates below 100/100,000 (Calgary)
 - Another number of days
- An expiry date
 - December 31, 2021 (current)
 - Another date
- Remove triggers/expiry
 - Leave the bylaw in place until Council directs otherwise

Bylaw amendment

- **Remove caseload trigger and expiry date**
 - This keeps the bylaw in place

Direction for the future

- **Set the conditions for future discussion**

Additional Triggers for Consideration

- Amendments to have the bylaw automatically repeal when all of the following conditions are met:
 - after the active case rate for the Edmonton zone falls below 100/100,000 population for 28 consecutive days;
 - 2 weeks after 80% of children aged 5-11 in the Edmonton zone have been fully vaccinated;
 - ICU utilization falls below 50% of usual capacity; and
 - the provincial chief medical officer of health order requiring indoor masking has been rescinded.
