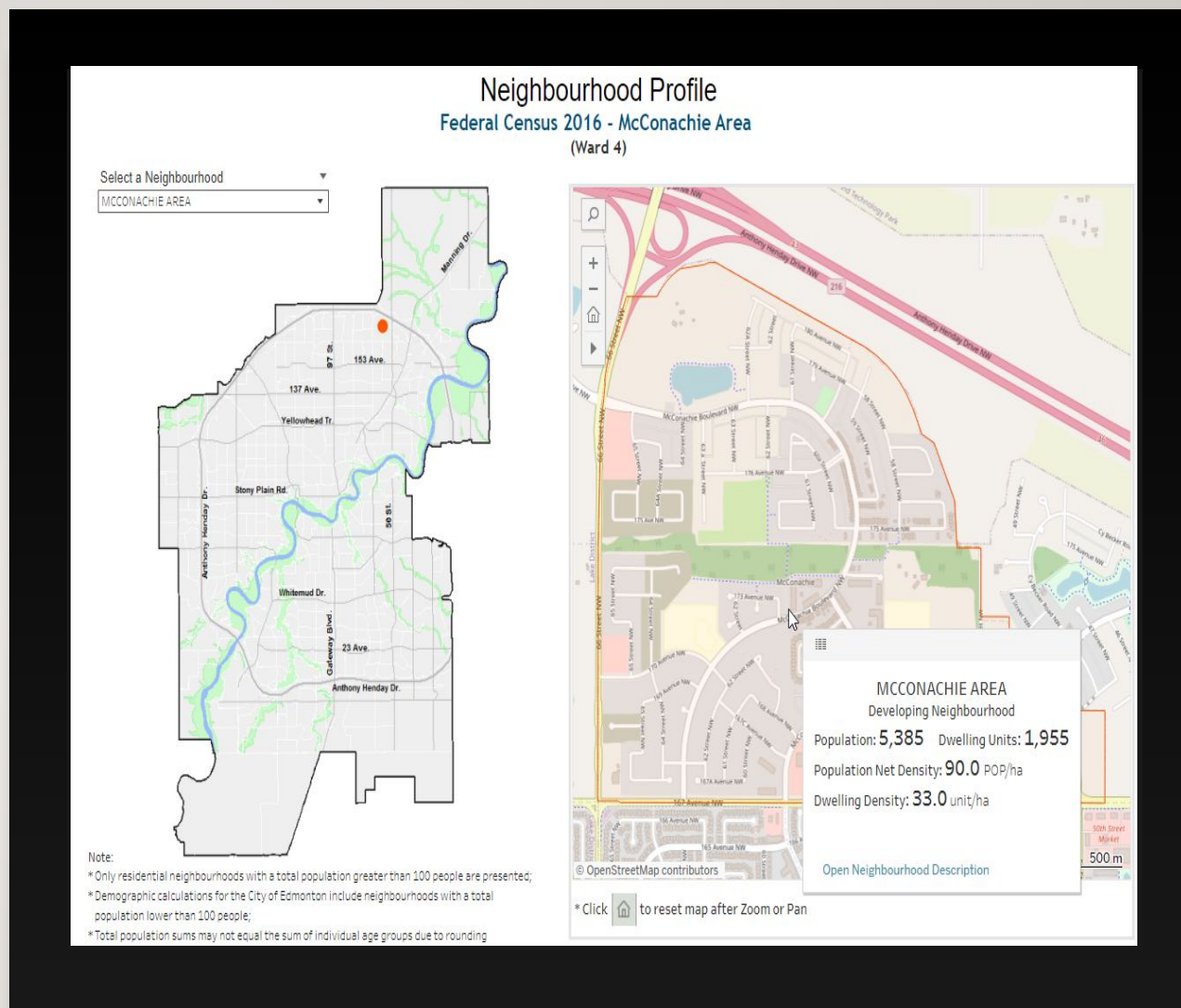

## LITTLE LEAGUE BASEBALL EDMONTON

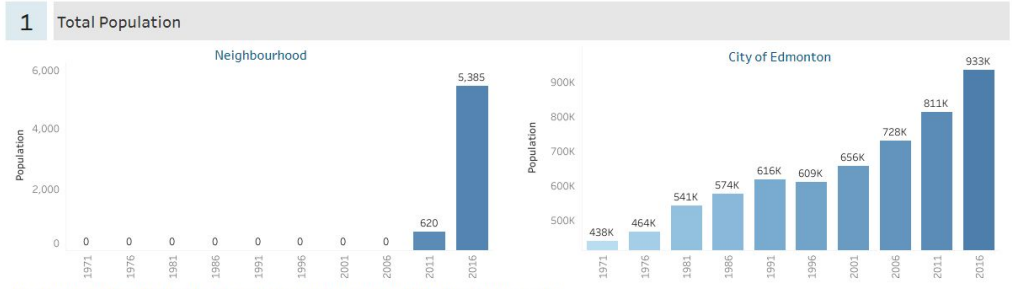
- Community Park Little League EST. 1991 operates a Home base agreement with the City of Edmonton

## DEMOGRAPHICS

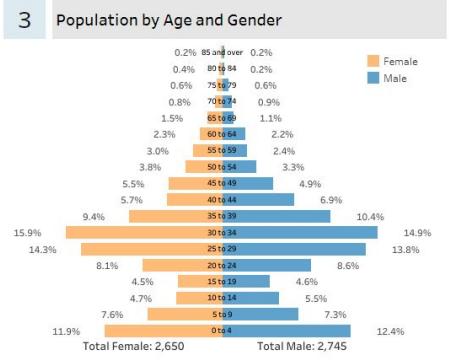
- Well over 1200 youth playing baseball in Little League alone.
- Edmonton is one of the fastest growing cities in Canada.
- New communities are being built with little or no sporting infrastructure.
- Current infrastructure does not fully support children with Cognitive or Physical disabilities.

- Using McConachie as an example from 2011-2016 grew by almost 5000.
- There are many new communities being built and no further infrastructure to support sporting activity in many areas.
