BY-LAW NO. 254

A By-law to authorize the transfer of certain lands to the Grand Trunk Pacific Railway Company.

WHEREAS by the terms of a certain agreement made the 6th day of March, 1906, between the Grand Trunk Pacific Railway Company and the Corporation of the City of Edmonton, which said agreement is fully set forth in Chapter 46 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1907, the Corporation agreed to acquire for the Company the right-of-way mentioned in said agreement;

AND WHEREAS all that part of Lots 115 and 116 in River Lot 6 in the City of Edmonton lying North of the Southerly boundary of the right-of-way of the said Company across said lots is part of the right-of-way mentioned in said agreement;

AND WHEREAS the Corporation has agreed to sell to the said Company all those parts of Lots 120, 121, 122, 123 and 124 in said River Lot lying South of the Southerly limit of the right-of-way of said Company across said lots, at and for the price of ~~\$8,500.00~~ ¹³500.00 ;

AND WHEREAS the Company has purchased said Lots 115 and 116 together with other lands and it has been agreed between the City and the Company that the value of said parts of lots 115 and 116 ^{namely \$8,500.00} agreed to be acquired by the Corporation for right-of-way as aforesaid shall be set off against said sum of \$13,542.00 , leaving the sum of \$5,042.00 to be paid by the said Company to the Corporation for a transfer of said parts of Lots 120, 121, 122, 123 and 124;

AND WHEREAS the Company has issued a voucher in favor of the Corporation for said sum of \$5,042.00 and has

requested the Corporation to execute a transfer of said parts of Lots 120, 121, 122, 123 and 124;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the City of Edmonton duly assembled, enacts as follows:-

1. The Mayor and Secretary-Treasurer are hereby authorized and empowered for and on behalf of the City of Edmonton to execute and affix the corporate seal to a transfer to the said Company of all those parts of Lots 120, 121, 122, 123 and 124 in River Lot 6 in the City of Edmonton lying South of the Southerly boundary of the right-of-way of the Company across said lots, *for said sum of \$ 5,042.00*
