## THE CITY OF EDMONTON BYLAW 19938

## TEMPORARY MANDATORY FACE COVERINGS BYLAW Amendment No. 6

Edmonton City Council enacts:

- 1. Bylaw 19408, Temporary Mandatory Face Coverings Bylaw, is amended by this bylaw.
- 2. Section 12 is added following section 11:

**REVIEW** 

- 12 (1) This bylaw must be reviewed by City Council within 30 days of the later of:
  - (a) the day on which the number of active COVID-19 cases in the City of Edmonton has been less than or equal to 100 per 100,000 population, as reported by Alberta Health, for 28 consecutive days; and
  - (b) the day on which the provincial Chief Medical Officer of Health order requiring face coverings is rescinded.
  - (2) Notwithstanding anything in this bylaw, if the number of active COVID-19 cases in the City of Edmonton is less than or equal to 100 per 100,000 population on the day this section comes into force, the 28-day period set out in subsection (1)(a) begins on the day this section comes into force.
  - (3) Nothing in this section requires Council to amend or repeal this bylaw following the review required by subsection (1).
