

Background

- → January 1, 2019: Edmonton annexes property from Leduc County
- → 2020: Some property owners in the annexed area raise concerns about tax increases
- → February 8, 2021: Council moved four motions regarding annexed area properties that experienced tax increases to:
 - cancel 2020 penalties and tax arrears COMPLETE
 - defer tax payment until end of 2021 COMPLETE
 - rebate 2020 taxes based on ARB reductions in 2021 COMPLETE



Current Status

- → This report outlines the cost to have owners' 2020 tax increases reduced by 75 percent and 2021 increases by 50 percent.
 - ♠ A Q1 2023 report will outline the cost to reduce 2022 increases by 25 percent.
 - These rebates would be applied as tax credits to owners' accounts.
- → A motion will be required today if Council wishes to proceed with this reduction.
