Purpose

To amend three maps and one policy.

Readings

This Charter Bylaw was advertised in the Edmonton Journal on February 25 and March 5, 2022. The Charter Bylaw can be passed following third reading.

Report

The purpose of proposed Bylaw 20007 is to amend the Oliver Area Redevelopment Plan to facilitate a rezoning that would allow for the development of a mid-rise Multi-unit Housing development (Charter Bylaw 20008). The maps and policy to be amended are:

- Map 3 Major Plan Initiatives
- Map 6 Sub Area 1 Zoning
- Map 7 Special Character Area
- Policy 5.5.1.8 Land Use Policies for Sub Area 1

All comments from civic departments or utility agencies regarding this proposal have been addressed.
