## To close a portion of 156 Street SW, in the Chappelle neighbourhood

## **Purpose**

To facilitate the development of the neighbourhood in accordance with the Chappelle Neighbourhood Area Structure Plan.

## **Readings**

Bylaw 18630 is ready for three readings after the public hearing has been held. If Council wishes to give three readings during a single meeting, Council must unanimously agree "That Bylaw 18630 be considered for third reading."

## **Advertising and Signing**

This Bylaw was advertised in the Edmonton Journal on March 18, 2022 and March 26, 2022. The Bylaw can be passed following third reading.

#### **Position of Administration**

Administration supports this proposed Bylaw.

#### Report

This application proposes to close a portion of the 156 Street SW road right-of-way located north of Chegwin Wynd SW. The closure area will accommodate a future Greenway/Multi-use Trail and is in conformance with the Chappelle Neighbourhood Area Structure Plan (NASP).

The proposed closure meets the technical requirements of civic departments and utility agencies.

A sales agreement has been executed with the purchaser.
