REPORT

Daniela O'Callaghan, Chair, will present the 2021 Annual Report and the 2022 Work Plan.

Under Bylaw 15638, Edmonton Combative Sports Commission Bylaw, the Commission is established to control and regulate all aspects of professional combative sports, with the exception of sports entertainment wrestling, and all professional combative sport events in the City. The Commission is comprised of seven citizen members and is supported by an Executive Director. The Executive Director is a City Administrative position responsible for supporting the Commission and operational functions related to combative sports events (e.g. licensing and permitting decisions).

In accordance with *City Policy C575C, Agencies, Boards, Committees and Commissions*, the Edmonton Combative Sports Commission annually reports to City Council on its activities. The Commission's annual reports for 2021 and the 2022 priorities are provided as Attachment 1.
