

BYLAW 20021

To amend the Central McDougall/Queen Mary Park Area Redevelopment Plan

Purpose

To amend one map.

Readings

Bylaw 20021 is ready for three readings after the public hearing has been held. If Council wishes to give three readings during a single meeting, Council must unanimously agree “That Bylaw 20021 be considered for third reading.” Council for third and final reading (see attached Council report for more information).
