They stated that they plan to sell urns at the location at last year's public hearing.

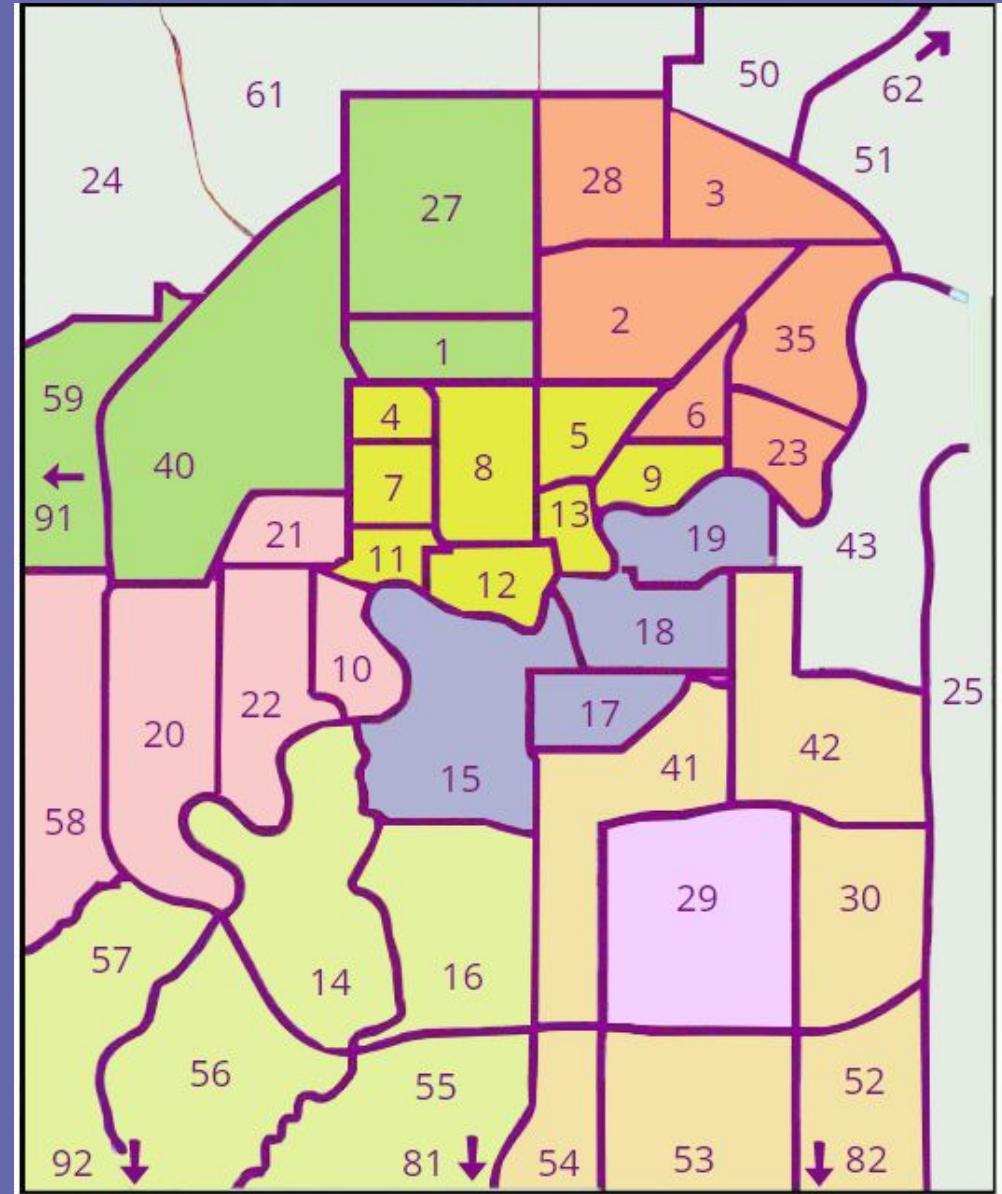
They know our opposition and they are proceeding regardless
