The City of Edmonton Fire Rescue Services Bylaw Amendment No. 5

Purpose

To amend Schedules A, B, C and D of the Fire Rescue Services Bylaw 15309 to reflect inflationary increases for providing services.

Readings

Bylaw 18270 is ready for three readings.

This Bylaw is authorized under the *Municipal Government Act*, *Safety Codes Act* and the *Traffic Safety Act*. A majority vote of City Council on all three readings is required for passage.

If Council wishes to give three readings during a single meeting, then prior to moving third reading, Council must unanimously agree "That Bylaw 18270 be considered for third reading".

This Bylaw will amend the Fire Rescue Services Bylaw and its fee schedule for 2018.

As a result of the 2018 Supplementary Operating Budget Adjustments, the Fire Rescue Services Bylaw has been updated to reflect the 2018 Consumer Price Index increase.
