## NEXT STEPS, PUBLIC SAFETY PLAN

- By June 9th
- Letter to the Government of Alberta
- Public Safety Plan which includes:
  - Immediate 30 day actions
  - 60 day actions
  - 5 Point Action Plan

## CHINATOWN IMMEDIATE SAFETY PLAN

- Fund business security (\$300,000)
- Fund community recovery (\$1,000,000)
- Install public washrooms, streetscape
- Clarify work of bylaw officers, police and private security
- Clean up needles, roads, alleys
- Increase communications with businesses and social agencies

## NEXT ACTIONS

- Community Enhancement Plan
- Decentralization/ permitting of social services
- Provincial and federal advocacy
- Increase communications with businesses and social agencies

## ACTION PLAN

We have developed a multi-part plan to take action:

- Community Safety and Well-Being Strategy
- Transit Safety and Security Plan
- Anti-Racism Strategy
- \$5 million from provincially provided Downtown Safety and Vibrancy initiative funds
- Multidisciplinary Approach

## MULTIDISCIPLINARY APPROACH

- **Saturation policing:** more “boots on the ground” in the Downtown, Chinatown and Alberta Avenue areas, high-visibility and high-engagement.
- **Problem identification and creation of multidisciplinary ad hoc project teams:** Community Support Teams comprised of available City resources and EPS to address issues.
- **Create sustainable shared work models:** standard service level(s) for high-risk/high-demand areas of the city.
