

Social Vulnerability Index Criteria

1. Education - proportion of individuals 15 years and over without a certificate, diploma or degree.
2. Employment - unemployment rate.
3. Government Transfer Payments - proportion of family income composed of government transfer payments.
4. Home Ownership - percentage of owned occupied private dwellings.
5. Immigration - percent of the population who immigrated in the period 2011-2016.
6. Income - prevalence of low income after tax.
7. Language - percent of individuals who do not speak either official language.
8. Lone Parent - proportion of families headed by a lone parent.
9. Mobility - proportion of individuals who are living at a different address from the one at which they resided one year earlier.
