

City of Edmonton Permit Fees

Year	Tier II Permit Fee
2020	\$147.00
2021	\$147.00
2022 (proposed)	\$100.00

- Fireworks permits require 5 business day notice for processing.
- Some activities in public parks and open spaces require a permit or other guidance to ensure public areas are safe, maintained and accessible.
 - Parkland permits are currently free.

Fireworks and Public Safety Risk

Recommended Approach

Issue permits for certified, professional fireworks discharge only. Eliminate "Tier I" Permits:

- Very few private residential lots in Edmonton eligible for the permit
- Difficult to enforce
 - Creates additional liability for the City
- Unprofessional use is directly linked to injuries and increased fire risk

Reduce "Tier II" Permit Fees:

• From \$147 to \$100

Desired Outcomes

- Fireworks in Edmonton would only be discharged by certified professionals in possession of a valid permit.
- The number of fires and injuries attributed to fireworks within city limits is anticipated to decrease.
- Increased awareness that non-professional firework use is not permitted.
- Simplified Bylaw and Police enforcement.
- Community and cultural groups host firework events with professional fireworks operators at a more accessible cost, through a streamlined-approval process.

Next Steps

If the recommendations are approved, Administration will:

- Commence stakeholder consultation to implement a phasing-out of Tier I permits and facilitate a transition for current vendors and potential applicants.
- Prepare amendments to the Fire Rescue Services Bylaw 15309 for Council Approval:
 - Consolidate fireworks permits ensuring all fireworks use requires a Fireworks Operator Certificate
 - Reduce "Tier II" permit fees from \$147 to \$100, under Schedule B-Permits.
