

## **BYLAW 19975 - Amending Bylaw 19091 Emergency Management Bylaw**

### **RECOMMENDATION**

That Bylaw 19975 be given the appropriate readings.

### **Purpose**

To amend the membership of the Emergency Advisory Committee from all members of Council to the members of Executive Committee.

### **Readings**

Bylaw 19975 is ready for three readings.

A majority vote of City Council on all three readings is required for passage.

If Council wishes to give three readings during a single meeting, then prior to moving third reading, Council must unanimously agree “That Bylaw 19975 be considered for third reading.”

### **Position of Administration**

Administration supports this Bylaw.

### **Report Summary**

Amendments to Bylaw 19091 Emergency Management Bylaw are recommended to update the membership of the Emergency Advisory Committee from all members of Council to the members of Executive Committee. This recommendation is aligned with best practices and is recommended by the Government of Alberta’s Alberta Emergency Management Agency (AEMA), who lead the coordination and cooperation of all Alberta organizations involved in emergencies and disasters.

### **REPORT**

Bylaw 19091, Emergency Management Bylaw, appoints the Emergency Advisory Committee and Emergency Management Agency, and prescribes roles and responsibilities for the City's emergency management processes.

## **BYLAW 19975 - Amending Bylaw 19091 Emergency Management Bylaw**

This bylaw proposes updates to the membership of the Emergency Advisory Committee from all members of Council to the members of Executive Committee.

Section 5(2) is deleted and replaced with:

All Councillors appointed to Executive Committee pursuant to Bylaw 18156, Council Committees Bylaw, are members of the Emergency Advisory Committee
