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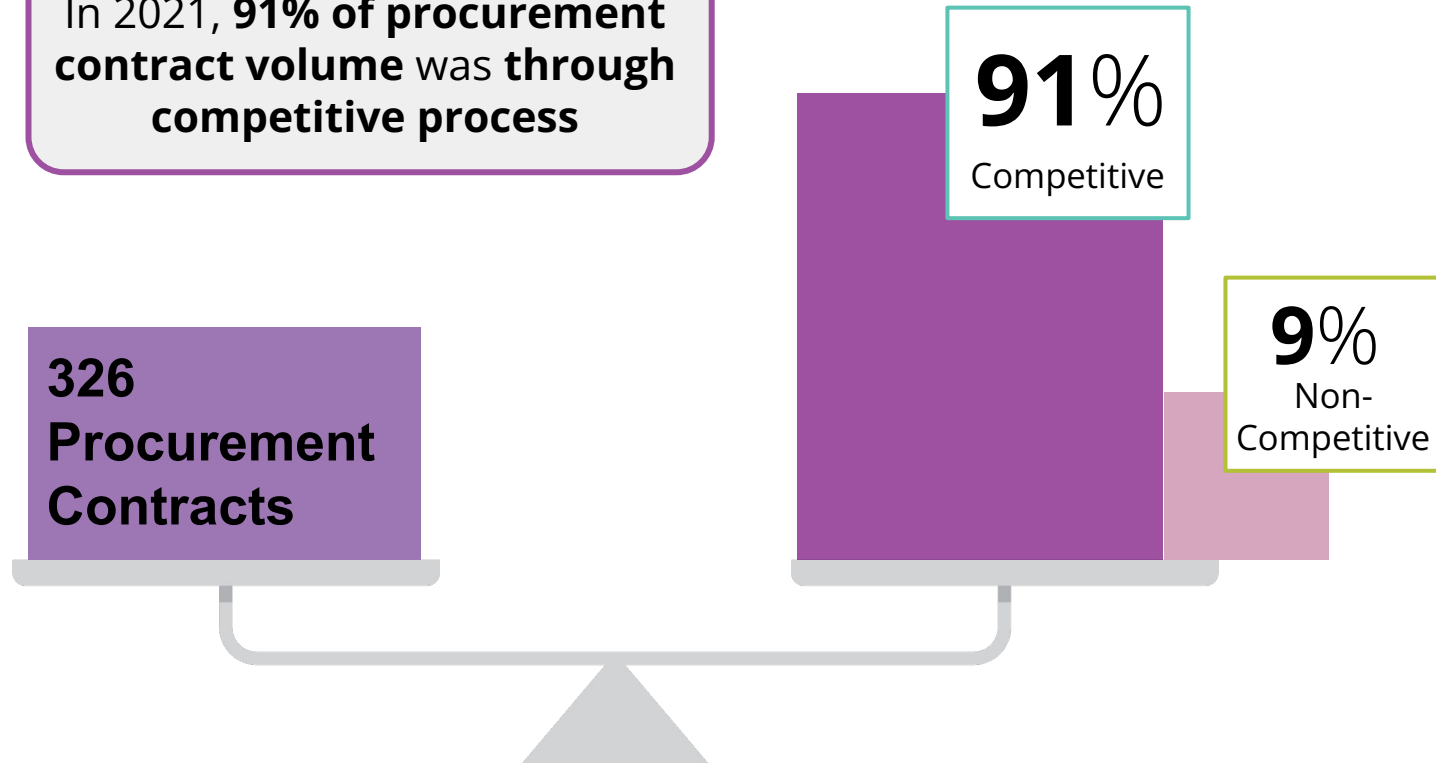

# Overview of the Terminology

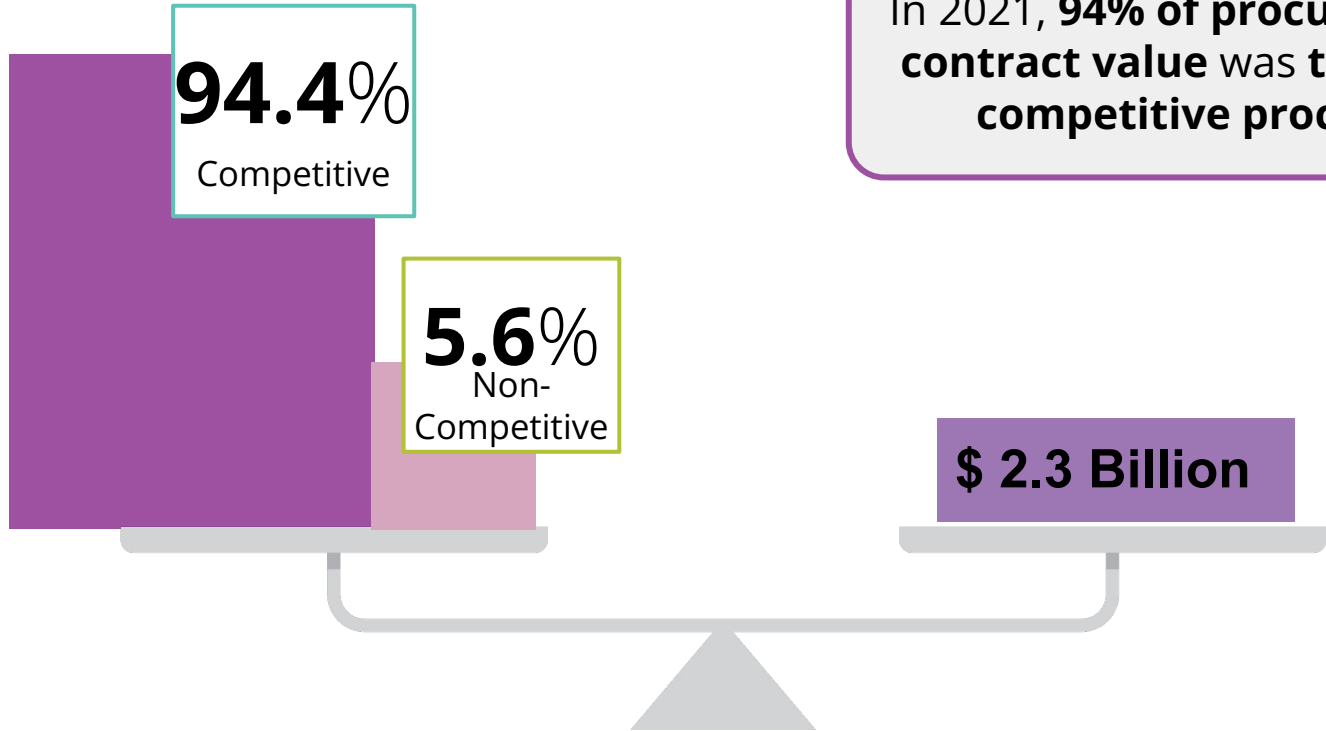
	Definition
Competitive Procurement	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• All suppliers have an equal chance to bid for an opportunity</li><li>• Notification is posted in multiple locations</li><li>• All compliant bids are reviewed by a formal evaluation committee using a consistent and predetermined evaluation process</li><li>• The competitive process typically leads to one of the following:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ standing arrangements</li><li>○ pre-qualified lists</li><li>○ typical contracts</li></ul></li></ul>
Non-Competitive Procurement	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Suppliers do not compete for the option to enter into a Contract with the City</li><li>• Completed in accordance with the Non-Competitive Procurement Procedure</li></ul>

## Procurement Summary - By Volume

In 2021, **91% of procurement contract volume** was through competitive process



## Procurement Summary - By Value



In 2021, **94%** of procurement contract value was through competitive process



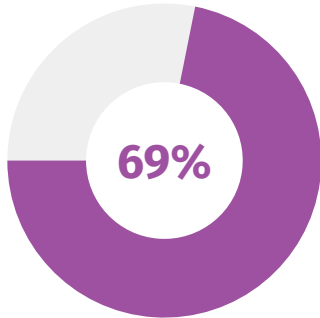
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# Local Procurement

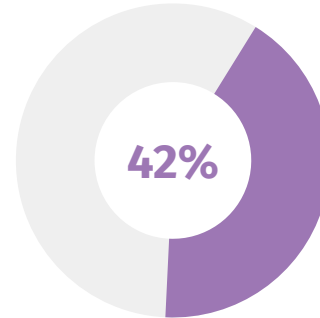
## Local Procurement

- any supplier with a business address containing a postal code in the capital region



### Competitive

69% of competitive procurements are awarded to local suppliers in 2021



### Non Competitive

42% of non competitive procurements are awarded to local suppliers in 2021

## Social Procurement

- Includes criteria from the Social Procurement Framework in areas of employment, skills and training, social value supply chain, and community development.

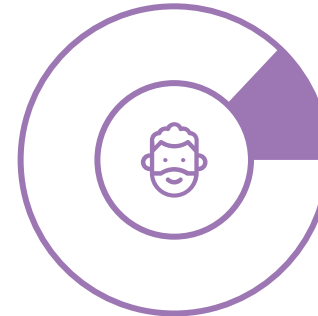
Competitive Procurements posted to the market including social procurement criteria
