That the amended Capital Profile 03-28-4147, Louise McKinney Riverfront Park, as outlined in Attachment 4 of the Community Services report CR_169, be approved and that \$4 million in Capital Financing be released for prioritization for other growth projects as part of the 2015-2018 Capital Priority Plan.*
- 3. That Administration prioritize the completion of the Louise McKinney Park for funding in the 2019-2022 Capital Budget and provide a report in the first quarter of 2018.*
