Report Summary

This Bylaw provides debt financing for Integrated Infrastructure Services Project, Fire Station #8 Relocation - Blatchford.

REPORT

During the 2021 Fall Supplemental Capital Budget Adjustment deliberations from November 30, 2021 to December 17, 2021, Council approved a new profile 21-10-9105 Fire Station #8 Relocation - Blatchford within the 2019-2022 Capital Budget with a total project budget of \$23,657,000. To complete this project, it will be necessary to borrow \$23,657,000.

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Bylaw 19981 will be resubmitted for second and third readings after the advertising and the expiration of the associated petition period.

COMMUNITY INSIGHTS
