



## **COMMUNITY AND PUBLIC SERVICES COMMITTEE REPORT**

### **Snow and Ice Control - Programmed Approach for the 2022-2023 Winter Season**

#### ***Recommendation of the Committee***

1. That the Parks and Roads Services branch budget be increased by \$4.7M, from the Financial Stabilization Reserve, on a one time basis to fund the Snow and Ice Control program for the 2022 portion of the upcoming winter season.
2. That Administration prepare a capital profile and operating service package for consideration during the 2023-2026 fall budget deliberations, to support approved enhancements to the Snow and Ice Control program as outlined in R1/AP1 in Attachment 2 of the June 27, 2022, City Operations report CO01277.
