CFTA: Canadian Free Trade Agreement (between Canada, all Provinces, Territories, and all public entities, including municipalities).

CETA: Canada-European Union Comprehensive and Economic Free Trade Agreement (between Canada and the EU, and Canada's public entities, including municipalities).

UK: Canada-UK Trade Continuity Agreement (between Canada and the UK, when the UK exited the EU, and Canada's public entities, including municipalities).

WTO GPA: World Trade Organization Agreement on Government Procurement - applicable only to Provincial/Territorial level governments currently.

CPTPP: Comprehensive and Progressive Agreement for Trans-Pacific Partnership -(between Canada Australia, Brunei, Chile, Japan, Malaysia, Mexico, New Zealand, Peru, Singapore and Vietnam, and Canada's Provinces/Territories).
