

Introduction



Current Off-Leash Establishment Processes

City-led Capital Projects: City-funded projects that are designed, build, maintained and operated by the City.

Developer Projects: Built by developers as part of new neighbourhoods, then maintained and operated by the City.

Temporary Off-Leash Pilot Program: Fully enclosed amenities on league licensed-land (winter ice rinks, tennis and basketball courts)

Privately Run: Built and managed by businesses or not-for-profits on privately owned land. The Dogs in Open Spaces strategy encourages this option, although the City is not involved in operating these off-leash areas.



Options for Community-Initiated Off-leash Areas

Community Group Led Construction Process

Community Groups are responsible for:

- → Submitting the initial project proposal
- Community Needs Assessment and Public Engagement
- → Managing the project
- → Raising funds to finance the project
- Meeting legal requirements, obtaining permits and approvals
- Operating and maintaining the facility (municipal improvement agreement required)







Next Steps



- Continue with city-led capital and developer-led projects
- Evaluation of the Temporary
 Off-leash Pilot Program
- → If directed, proceed with multi-phased plan
