COMMUNITY INSIGHT

EWSI engaged stakeholders in 2021, including the general public, in respect to a number of its initiatives. Insights from these activities are reported to Council as needed, specifically with details of the applicable projects. Some examples include:

- Discussion with the City of Edmonton and local communities to help identify locations for dry ponds (SIRP);
- Completion of a public opinion survey of the Backwater Valve Subsidy Program;
- Development of stakeholder engagement plans for all major capital projects, and;
- Engagement with the City of Edmonton and the Infill Development in Edmonton Association (IDEA) to develop the Infill Cost Sharing Program.
