Readings

Advertising and Signing

This Bylaw was advertised in the Edmonton Journal on August 12, 2022 and August 20, 2022. The Bylaw can be passed following third reading.

Position of Administration

Report

Bylaw 20220 proposes to amend the Decoteau Area Structure Plan to reflect the changes to the transportation network, and locations of low and medium density residential, commercial, institutional, park, and public utility uses proposed within the Decoteau North Neighbourhood (Bylaw 20221). Maps, figures, and land use and population statistics will be revised to align with the proposed change

This plan amendment is associated with an amendment to the Decoteau North Neighbourhood Structure Plan (Bylaw 20221) and a proposed rezoning (Charter Bylaw 20222).

All comments from civic departments and utility agencies have been addressed.
