- City less safe than existing
- APLT is safest

Conclusion

- City Administration advocates an option that
 - is less safe
 - is costlier
 - does not meet standards
- Council must refer the application back

Development Review Process

- Must meet City "standards"
- Must meet City policies, for example Vision Zero
- Must engage affected residents
- Must be transparent engagement
