Community Traffic Safety Award (B. Esslinger/D. Loken)

Councillors B. Esslinger and D. Loken, on behalf of City Council, presented L. Langlois with the Community Traffic Safety Award. Having noticed a high number of crashes involving motorcycles, she worked to create public awareness, and through the connections she made with local media, established the Alberta Motorcycle Safety Society two years ago. She was able to raise the profile of motorcycle safety throughout the city and the province. The Alberta Motorcycle Safety Society gained further recognition this spring, when they partnered with Vision Zero, for the launch of Motorcycle Safety Month in May.
