Objective

Active recreation, sport and leisure opportunities significantly contribute to the quality of life in Edmonton. Edmontonians value active, healthy lifestyles and want their municipal government to work with them to create invigorating recreation opportunities accessible to the widest range of abilities, ages, culture and incomes. Recreation facilities serve as community hubs bringing people together in welcoming and vibrant settings.

The City of Edmonton provides significant support to recreation and sport communities in Edmonton. The City is working both with partners and directly to deliver projects to provide enhanced public recreation opportunities.

The Recreation Facility Master Plan and supporting plans guide the direction of facility development. There are several plans and strategies underway that provide more detailed direction for facility and program development. Based on these plans there are numerous facilities under development and redevelopment (see lists below).

Specific objectives include:

- Increase the quality and quantity of sports and recreation opportunities in Edmonton.
- Ensure alignment of recreation and sport efforts and initiatives with strategic policy directions.
