Recommendations

1. That the following Council Initiatives be concluded:

2. That the Economic Development - Port Alberta Council Initiative be transferred to Administration to work with the Edmonton Economic Development Corporation and the Edmonton International Airport.
3. That Administration and the Council Sponsors for the Council Initiative, Economic Development- Heartland, work with the Alberta Industrial Heartland Association to advance desired outcomes of the Initiative to the Association, and close the initiative.
4. That Administration work with the Council Initiative, Edmonton's Poverty Elimination, to bring forward an updated terms of reference to Council early in the 2017-2021 term, for its consideration.
5. That the ELEVATE Council Initiative be concluded and that Administration bring a draft terms of reference for a Community Hubs Initiative, to Council early in the 2017-2021 term, for its consideration.
