

### Proposed Fee Structure for Use of Road Right-of-Way

As per the current Safety Codes Permit Bylaw 15894, the monthly fees charged for the use of road right-of-way are as follows:

- Sidewalk: \$3.89 per square metre of sidewalk or roadway occupied in the first 2.4 metres from the edge of the sidewalk or roadway (\$0.31/m per day)
- Boulevard: \$4.97 for each lineal metre of boulevard occupied (\$0.17/m per day)
- Parking Lane: \$3.89 per square metre of sidewalk or roadway occupied in the first 2.4 metres from the edge of the sidewalk or roadway (\$0.31/m per day)
- Travel Lane: \$15.21 per square metre of sidewalk or roadway occupied beyond 2.4 metres from the edge of the sidewalk or roadway (\$1.52/m per day)

The proposed daily fees for the use of road right-of-way to replace the existing monthly fees listed above, are shown below, alongside a comparison to the City of Calgary's current fees. Edmonton's proposed fee will be applied for work completed during the peak periods (6:00-9:00 and 15:30-18:30) along arterial roads. Work done along collector and local roads with a duration of more than 8 hours would have a reduced fee structure.
