

Proposed Construction Hoarding Policy Procedures - Policy C580A

CITY PROCEDURES

- A permit in relation to construction hoarding is required for:
 - All work that involves excavation of roadways, sidewalks, or boulevards;
 - Non-excavation work that interferes with traffic flows on major roadways during the hours of 6:00-9:00 and/or 15:30-18:30 excluding weekends and holidays;
 - All work on freeways, river crossings, in the downtown core, or Whyte Avenue area;
 - All work with a duration of more than four hours at any one location. Multiple work locations less than 250m apart are considered to be one location;
 - The covering of a pedestrian and/or cyclists facility (sidewalk, shared-use path, cycle track) in relation to the Alberta Building Code requirements;
 - The placement of a waste bin or pod;
 - Temporary on-street parking;
 - Temporary crossing of the curb/sidewalk/boulevard.
- Fees will be established for the construction hoarding related permits.
- Modal priorities will be established throughout the City in the accommodation of construction hoardings as follows:
 - Within Permit Zone A, which generally includes Business Improvement Areas, arterial roadways and areas of post secondary institutions, the following modal priority is established to accommodate high pedestrian and cyclist activity:
 - Pedestrians
 - Cyclists
 - Public Transit
 - Private Vehicle

- Within Zone B, which generally includes residential and industrial areas, the following balanced modal priority is established to accommodate typical pedestrian and cyclist activity:
 - Pedestrians/Cyclists/Public Transit/Private Vehicle
