

Collaborative Relationship Agreement - Key Terms

Parties:	City of Edmonton and Edmonton Federation of Community Leagues (EFCL)
Term:	January 1, 2023 to December 31, 2026
Funding:	Operational funding to be provided to the Edmonton Federation of Community Leagues on an annual basis in an amount determined by City Council in its sole discretion.
EFCL Commitments	EFCL will provide leadership and guidance to Community Leagues in areas including, but not limited to, volunteer mobilization; fund development; board governance; planning, infrastructure stewardship, diversity and inclusion, communications and membership.
City Commitments	The City will provide guidance and support to EFCL and its members in the following areas: City bylaw education and awareness; licensing and permitting; land use; stewardship of parkland; community-led projects; City grants; revitalization of neighbourhoods.
Joint Commitments	The City and EFCL will both contribute to the following areas: League coordination; public engagement; infrastructure lifecycle; partnerships; neighbourhood strategy; revitalization and Tripartite Agreement.
Termination	The City can terminate the agreement: a) in the event of a substantial breach by EFCL; b) if EFCL defaults in the performance of its obligations under the agreement and fails to remedy such default within 10 business days; or c) upon 30 days written notice if EFCL ceases to exist or function as a non-profit, is amalgamated or merged with another society or becomes bankrupt.
