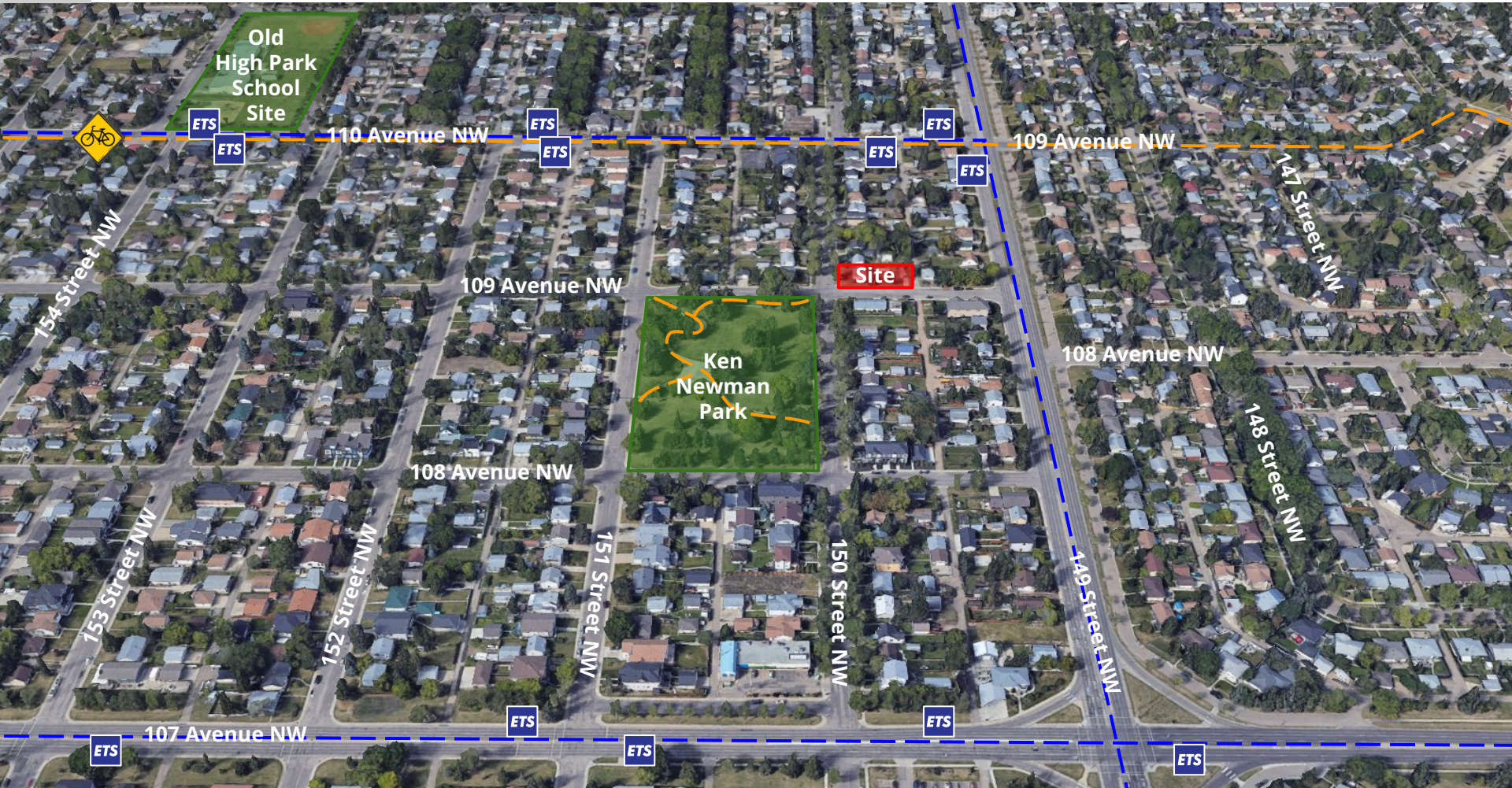

- The general disruption that can accompany redevelopment



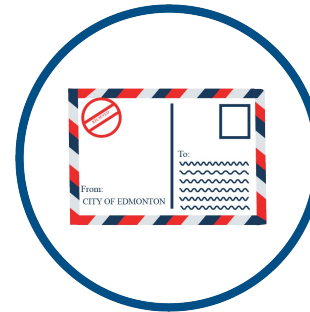

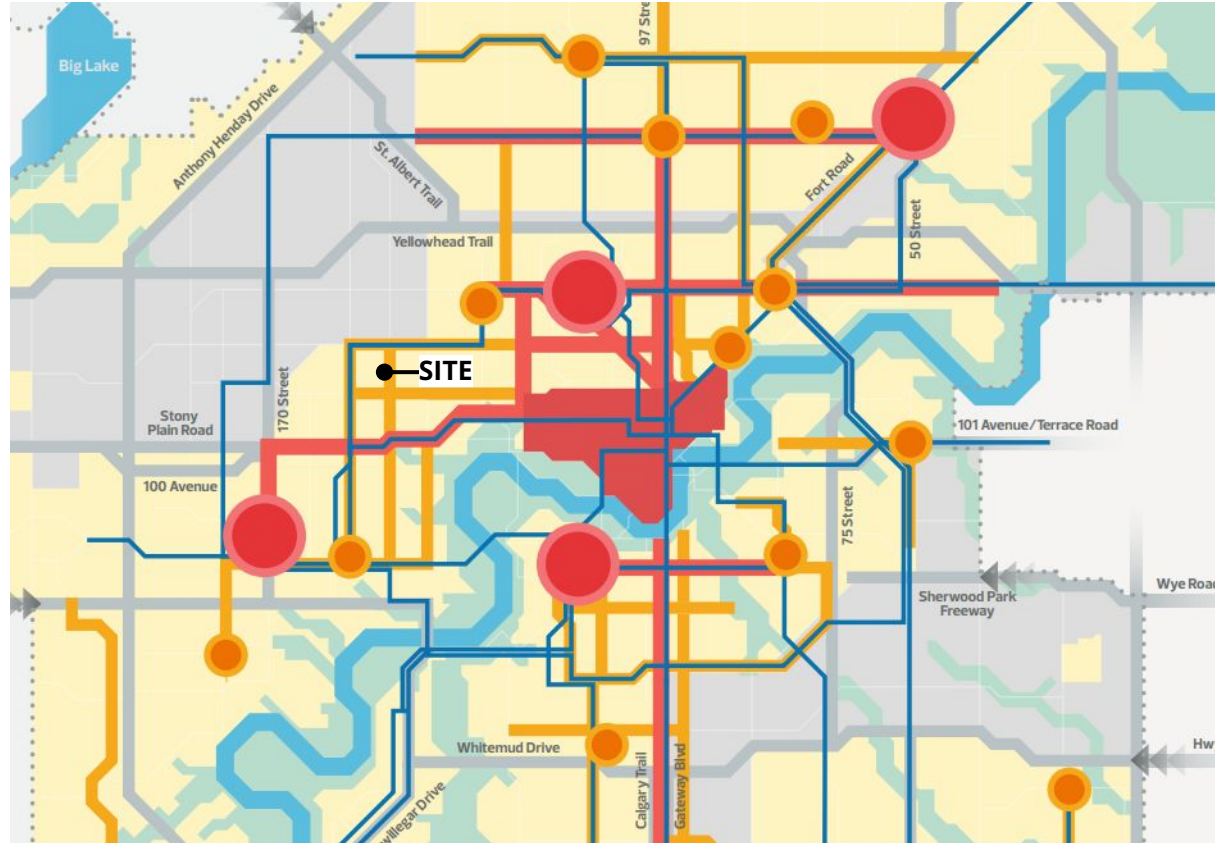
