10.1 Events Funding (T. Cartmell)

Councillor T. Cartmell stated that at the next regular meeting of City Council, he would move the following:

That Administration bring an unfunded service package to the 2023-2026 budget deliberations to increase the operating budget of Partnerships & Event Strategy to support Do North's bid to host the Professional Triathlon Association's Canadian Open in 2023 and 2024 and the Canadian Open and Multi Sport World Championships in 2025, to include one-time budget increases in the amounts of \$500,000 in 2023, \$625,000 in 2024 and \$1.2 million for 2025.

10.2 Housing and Homelessness - Revised Housing Strategy (E. Rutherford)

Councillor E. Rutherford stated that at the next regular meeting of City Council, she would move the following:

That Administration incorporate the entire housing continuum (emergency shelter to market housing) into the revised housing strategy to ensure a comprehensive, systemic and interconnected approach to addressing housing and homelessness. This will include working with the Province on responses to immediate needs of unsheltered individuals, transitions into housing, as well as, innovative solutions to address core housing needs.
