Bylaw 18067

Municipal Reserve Designation, Haddow Park

Purpose

To designate Lot 31, Block 12, Plan 0124854, Lot 32, Block 12, Plan 0224202, and Lot 77, Block 12, Plan 0227188 - Haddow Park - as Municipal Reserve (MR) in accordance with the *Municipal Government Act*.

Readings

Bylaw 18067 is ready for three readings after the public hearing has been held. If Council wishes to give three readings during a single meeting, Council must unanimously agree "That Bylaw 18067 be considered for third reading."

Report

Haddow Park is located in the middle of the Haddow neighbourhood. It contains a playground and playing fields. A future school is designated for the northern part of the site, but is unfunded. The park was acquired as Municipal Reserve (MR) in 2001 and 2002, and reserve dedication was removed in 2012 to allow for flexibility with respect to a surplus school site development. Replacing the MR designation formalizes its status as a park and offers protection against disposal and incompatible uses.
