RESERVE DESIGNATION BYLAW (Haddow)

Whereas, pursuant to section 665 (1) of the Municipal Government Act, a Council may pass bylaws designating parcels of land it owns as Municipal Reserve, School Reserve or Municipal and School reserve:

PART 1 - PURPOSE, DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION

PURPOSE

1. This bylaw designates certain lands owned by the City of Edmonton as Municipal Reserve.

PART 2 - PARCELS TO BE DESIGNATED AS MUNICIPAL RESERVE

PARCELS TO BE DESIGNATED AS MUNICIPAL RESERVE 2. Council hereby requires that the following parcel generally shown on Schedule A be designated as Municipal Reserve by the Registrar of Alberta Land Titles:

PLAN 0124854 BLOCK 12 LOT 31

EXCEPTING THEREOUT ALL MINES AND MINERALS

PLAN 0224202 BLOCK 12 LOT 32

EXCEPTING THEREOUT ALL MINES AND MINERALS

PLAN 0227188 BLOCK 12 LOT 77

EXCEPTING THEREOUT ALL MINES AND MINERALS

3. The Registrar shall do all things necessary to give effect to this bylaw, including cancelling the existing Certificate of Title and issuing a new Certificate of Title with the designation of Municipal Reserve, which shall be identified by a number suffixed by the letters "MR".

PART 3 - GENERAL
