Urban Planning and Economy Budget - Grants

The Edmonton Edge Fund program is generally consistent with Council Policy C623B - Edmonton Economic Recovery Grant, to promote a resilient business community by offering targeted financial assistance based on demonstrated business need. However, the Edge Fund is distinguished by three main features: it will not specify a maximum value per grant, it will not require a matching 100 per cent contribution upfront, and it will not require a reimbursement to the City. The Edge Fund will be focused on incentivizing economic growth. Grants of smaller amounts are available for targeted business investments through the existing Edmonton Economic Action Plan Grant. In addition, working with other members of the ecosystem will be key, such as Edmonton Unlimited and Edmonton Global.

The City is committed to providing various supports to local businesses and entrepreneurs, including partnering with organizations to provide foundational education and capacity building for local businesses and entrepreneurs, as well as providing economic grants. The benefit of such grants has been that they produce strong leverage ratios where every dollar invested by the City results in follow-on private investment.

The table below details the programs which received grants from the Urban Planning and Economy department budget throughout 2020 and 2021.
