#### NOTES TO THE BUDGET

- Note 1: We are seeking an increase to our levy in 2023. We will be transferring \$46,000 from our reserve for our operating budget and funded marketing position. This portion is a decrease over last year. We will continue to look for ways to generate additional income through grants to support our activities. Our membership levy was decreased by 20% due to expected business loss in 2021 and remained unchanged in 2022. We are only seeking this small \$7000 increase to include some new large businesses planned to open in 2023.
- Note 2: Anticipated member financial participation in programming. We should continue to generate a small amount of revenue through our programs, but our significant change is due to some sponsorship commitments for our new Holliday parade as well as a larger grant to support clean up and beautification efforts.

- Note 3&4: The administration costs will change very minimal. We will maintain our staff in 2023 with no changes to the number of positions anticipated, however we will have a summer student for 2023 to support summer cleanup programming from June to August.
- Note 5: We will increase our programming and the level of sponsorships and grants. We have already secured grants that will allow us to plan for additional activities. This includes a Holiday Parade in 2023, additional clean up commitments and a return to in person events. Specifically a \$25,000 clean up grant, and \$15,000 in Parade Event revenue and Sponsorship. These will help offset the cost of increased activity.
- Note 6: Our opening reserve balance at the start of 2023 is anticipated to be \$255,000 and we have been funding a position with it and we will continue holding our reserves for a capital project and a Blatchford project when appropriate.
- Note 7: The Kingsway District Association's maximum tax levy amount for member businesses will remain the same as in previous years at \$7,000. The BIA does not have a minimum tax levy amount. We will be seeking a levy increase to make our way towards pre pandemic levels and to capture some of our new businesses coming in for 2023.
