• +/- 25% from the optimum to ensure equality across Wards

Future Growth

Ward Boundaries established to withstand three municipal elections

Lessons Learned from the 2021 Edmonton Election


Better alignment between municipal and school division Ward boundaries would:

- improve the voting process
- reduce the number of ballot styles



Proposed Boundary Adjustment: Calgary Trail South Neighbourhood from Ward Karhiio to Ward papastew

- No impact on eligible electors
- Minimal impact on population (11 residents)
- Involves small parcel of non-residential land (0.65km²)





Next Steps

- First reading of Bylaw 20304
- Two week advertising period, followed by a 60-day petition window
- Second and Third readings of Bylaw 20304
- Amended Ward boundaries come into effect on Election Day of the 2025 Edmonton Election (Monday, October 20 2025)
