Bylaw 20318

A Bylaw to amend Bylaw 16407, as amended, the Riverview Area Structure Plan

WHEREAS pursuant to the authority granted to it by the Municipal Government Act, on July 3, 2013, the Municipal Council of the City of Edmonton passed Bylaw 16407, being Riverview Area Structure Plan; and

WHEREAS from time to time Council considers it desirable to amend the Riverview Area Structure Plan; and

WHEREAS Council has amended the Riverview Area Structure Plan, through the passage of Bylaws 17267, 17735, 17895, 17968, 18568, 18959, 19156, 19356, 20003, 20113, and 20203; and

WHEREAS an application was received by Administration to amend the Riverview Area Structure Plan; and

NOW THEREFORE after due compliance with the relevant provisions of the Municipal Government Act RSA 2000, ch. M-26, as amended, the Municipal Council of the City of Edmonton duly assembled enacts as follows:

- 1. That Bylaw 16407, as amended, Riverview Area Structure Plan, is hereby further amended by:
 - a. Renumbering all sections in the ASP to align with the Table of Contents;
 - b. In Section 3.4.6 Parkland, Recreation Facilities and Schools, deleting the first sentence of the paragraph under the "District Activity Park" heading and replacing it with the following:

"The ASP includes a District Activity Park, which is intended to include several structures such as a multi-purpose recreation centre (which may include, but is not


- limited to, pools, arenas, gymnasiums, indoor soccer and fitness training area) a Public High School, a Catholic High School, a K-6 Francophone Elementary School, and associated parking";
- c. In the first sentence of Section 3.1 "Land Use and Population Statistics", replacing "five" with "four";
- d. In the "ASP Policy" and "Implementation" columns beside Objective 2.4.7(b) in Section 3.4.7 Ecology, replacing all references to "Neighbourhood 5" with "Neighbourhood 4";
- e. In the first sentence of Section 3.5.1 General Staging, replacing "five" with "four";
- f. Deleting the map "Bylaw 20203 Riverview Area Structure Plan (as amended)" and replacing it with "Bylaw 20318 Amendment to Riverview Area Structure Plan (as amended)" attached hereto as Schedule "A" and forming part of this bylaw;
- g. Deleting "TABLE 2 LAND USE AND POPULATION STATISTICS" and replacing it with "TABLE 2 LAND USE AND POPULATION STATISTICS", attached hereto as Schedule "B" and forming part of this bylaw;
- h. Deleting "Figure 5 Neighbourhood Units" and replacing it with "Figure 5 Neighbourhood Units", attached hereto as Schedule "C" and forming part of this bylaw;
- i. Deleting "Figure 6 Land Use Concept" and replacing it with "Figure 6 Land Use Concept", attached hereto as Schedule "D" and forming part of this bylaw;
- j. Deleting "Figure 7 Ecological Connectivity" and replacing it with "Figure 7 Ecological Connectivity", attached hereto as Schedule "E" and forming part of this
 bylaw;
- k. Deleting "Figure 8 Parkland, Recreational Facilities & Schools" and replacing it with "Figure 8 Parkland, Recreational Facilities & Schools", attached hereto as Schedule "F" and forming part of this bylaw;
- Deleting "Figure 9 Transportation Network" and replacing it with "Figure 9 –

- m. Deleting "Figure 10 Active Transportation Network" and replacing it with "Figure 10 Active Transportation Network", attached hereto as Schedule "H" and forming


