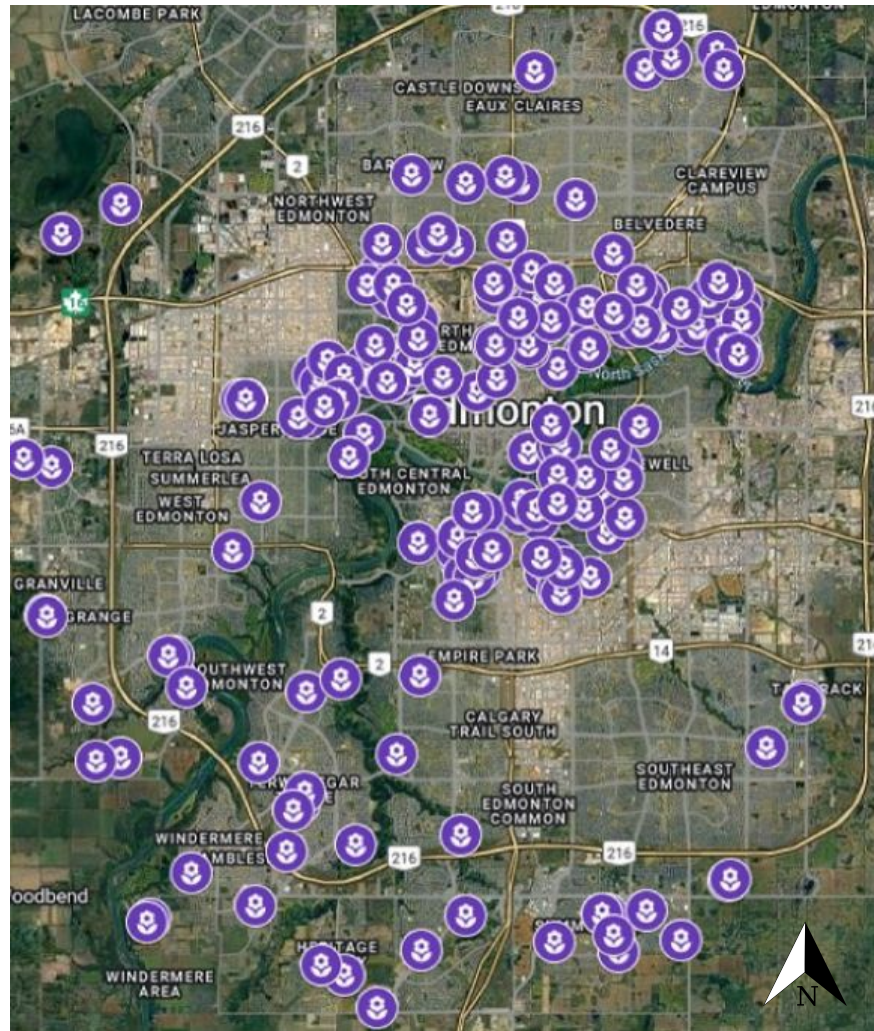

- Worked with EFCL on the program development



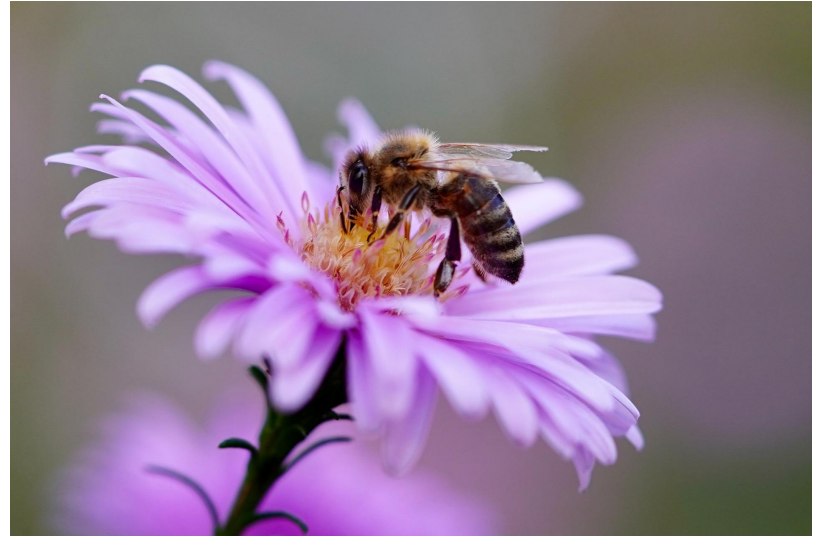
## Next Steps
