### STATUS UPDATE OF AVAILABLE FUNDING

#### ■ 2017/18 Provincial Budget

- MSI Funding = \$260.0M in 2017 vs \$264.8M in 2016
- \$(9.6)M projected MSI funding reduction for 2017 and 2018

#### ■ Investment Income

- > \$5.8M projected increase (\$3.0M in 2017 and \$2.8M in 2018)
- Due to modest improvement in economic forecast

#### □ Capital Profile Funding Releases

\$16.0M funding releases from tender savings, recosting and scope changes

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### NEW PROFILES RECOMMENDED FOR FUNDING (TAX SUPPORTED)

- 2.1-01 Infrastructure, Planning and Design Composite
  - Concept planning and design for Transportation, Facilities & Open Space
  - \$6.6M to be funded by Pay-As-You-Go
- 2.1-02 Glenridding Ravine Land Acquisition
  - Purchase of land to fulfill intent of Glenridding Ravine NHD Structure Plan
  - > \$6.4M funded by Parkland Purchase Reserve (\$4.1M) & PAYG (\$2.3M)
- 2.1-03 South Soccer Centre Expansion
  - Detailed design for adjacent facility with two additional fields
  - > \$2.0M to be funded by Enterprise Reserve



### PREVIOUSLY APPROVED PROFILES WITH ADDITIONAL FUNDING & SCOPE

- 2.1-04 Fort Edmonton Park Utilities & Enhancements
  - Original approved profile of \$70.8M for utility infrastructure upgrades
  - Increase profile to \$162.1M to reflect grant funding of \$91.3M for amenities
- 2.1-05 Lewis Farms Community Recreation and Library
  - > \$17.7M for design of recreation centre, library, & district park (Exec. Committee Apr. 21 CR\_3377); original profile \$3.7M for schematic design
  - Funded by tax-supported debt (\$16.8M) & partnership funding (\$0.9M)
- 2.1-06 Traffic Signals Pedestrian & Vehicle Safety
  - \$4.8M for additional safety enhancements (Council Mar. 21 CR\_4264)

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### NEW STAND-ALONE PROFILES Funding From Composites and Existing Sources

#### □ Funding From Existing Composites

- > 2.1-07 Bonnie Doon Pool Rehabilitation \$9.7M
- 2.1-08 Century Place Rehabilitation & Improvements \$19.7M
- 2.1-09 Civic Precinct Surface & Fountain Renewal \$13.0M

#### □ Funding From Other Existing Sources

- 2.1-10 Jasper Avenue New Vision Phase 2 \$3.4M
- 2.1-11 Alley Renewal \$0.5M (preliminary design work)

- □ Drainage Utility Budget Adjustments Reviewed by Utility Committee on April 24, 2017 (Agenda Item 6.4 CR\_4543)
  - > 2.1-12 Utilities, Planning and Design Composite
    - Concept planning and design for utility infrastructure \$1.3M
  - > 2.1-13 West Jasper Place Trunk Sewer Rehabilitation
    - Rehabilitation of three deep sanitary trunk sewers \$24.0M
  - > 2.1-14 Mill Creek Stormwater Management
    - Acquire land to lower and naturalize Mill Creek \$2.3M

#### Lewis Farms Recreation Centre - Land Acquisition

- Presented to Community and Public Services Committee on April 21, 2017 (CR\_3377)
- Land acquisition capital profile with a funding source strategy will be developed for the Fall 2017 SCBA
