Context

Motion from September 26/27, 2022, Community and Public Services Committee:

That Administration provide a report on updates on the Joint Use Agreement: Land review ongoing with school boards and how it could address aging infrastructure renewal (i.e., playgrounds) on school board owned lands.



Alignment





Joint Use Agreement: Land



- Guides the planning, assembly, design, development and maintenance of Joint Use sites for school and park purposes
- Agreement review is underway and is intended to define responsibilities for the renewal of playgrounds



Long-Term Real Estate Strategy



- A plan for school boards to structure growth in alignment with The City Plan's long-term development pattern
- Would identify where school sites will be needed based on anticipated population growth and supporting growth policies such as City Plan



Next Steps

- Administration and School Boards are working to explore the completion of the Long Term Strategy
 - Completed in tandem with the JUA: Land review and inform changes to the agreement
- Work on the Land Agreement continues; once complete the revised Agreement will be brought forward for Council consideration and approval
