

Naturalization and Maintenance Around Stormwater Management Facilities (SWMF)



- New SWMF are naturalized according to The City's Landscape Standards
- Some HOAs prefer a more manicured aesthetic around SWMFs
- In 2022, naturalization completed in 2021 was reversed in some SWMF, pending future public engagement



Communication and Engagement with HOAs

Parkland Care and Naturalization Campaign

- Increase clarity on service levels
- Provide education on naturalization including Stormwater Management Facilities

HOA Survey

- 80% of respondents were aware of service levels
- 70% of respondents desired increased service levels
- Desire for increased communication about programs and services related to landscape maintenance
