#### To amend the Windermere Area Structure Plan

## **Purpose**

To update statistics to align with an associated amendment to the Keswick Neighbourhood Structure Plan

## Readings

Bylaw 20177 is ready for three readings after the public hearing has been held. If Council wishes to give three readings during a single meeting, Council must unanimously agree that Bylaw 20177 be considered for third reading.

## **Advertising and Signing**

This Bylaw was advertised in the Edmonton Journal on March 17, 2023, and March 25, 2023. The Bylaw can be passed following third reading.

#### **Position of Administration**

Administration supports this proposed Bylaw.

## Report

Bylaw 20177 proposes to amend the Windermere Area Structure Plan by amending land use and population statistics to reflect a decrease in the size of a commercial site, and an increase to areas of low and medium density housing. This amendment is associated with a proposed amendment to the Keswick Neighbourhood Structure Plan (Bylaw 20178) and proposed rezoning (Charter Bylaw 20179).

All comments from civic departments or utility agencies regarding this proposal have been addressed.

# **Community Insights**

A notice of the proposed land use changes was mailed to surrounding property owners and the president of the Greater Windermere Community League on March 1, 2022. No responses were received.
