Overview of Project

The subsidy funding shall be provided to the Bissell Centre in support of day services operations as generally and non-exhaustively described as follows:

- Essential supplies, such as food, clothing and hygiene services
- Indigenous cultural services
- Housing services
- Referral and in-reach programs and services
- Day services operational supports

The subsidy agreement shall be in a form acceptable to Legal Services, and in a content acceptable to the Branch Manager of Social Development. The approval of the subsidy agreement includes the approval of such corrective, conformance, and incidental amendments to the General Terms and Conditions, and to the form and content, as necessary or desirable to give effect to implement the transaction, all as may be subsequently approved by the Branch Manager of Social Development.
